1. Each time Patricia makes a batch of cookies, they disappear. How many cookies are in a "batch"? (Hint: Find the recipe in the book.) Write down how many cookies are in each batch.

2. The recipe gives the number of cookies by saying how many "dozen" cookies the recipe will make. How many cookies make a "dozen"?

3. Multiply the number of dozens (answer to question 1) by how many cookies make up a dozen (answer to question 2) to find out how many cookies are made in each batch.

4. Count the number of times a batch of cookies disappear in the story. Write it down.
